Overview of Hartridge Academy

Hartridge Academy is a charter school located in Winter Haven, FL, which is in a mid-size suburb setting. The student population of Hartridge Academy is 205 and the school serves K-5. At Hartridge Academy, 92% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 92% scored at or above that level for reading.

The school's minority student enrollment is 45%. The student-teacher ratio is 19:1, which is worse than that of the district.

The student population is made up of 49% female students and 51% male students. The school enrolls 38% economically disadvantaged students. There are 11 equivalent full-time teachers.



Test Scores at Hartridge Academy

At Hartridge Academy, 92% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 92% scored at or above that level for reading.

Compared with the district, the school did better in math and better in reading, according to this metric. In Polk County Public Schools, 46% of students tested at or above the proficient level for reading, and 50% tested at or above that level for math.

Hartridge Academy did better in math andbetter in reading in this metric compared with students across the state. In Florida, 53% of students tested at or above the proficient level for reading, and 57% tested at or above that level for math.
